BUILDING PERMITS

Who Needs a Building Permit?

All construction, renovations demolitions, additions or moving a building require a permit. Please make application at the Town Office

in advance, as approval by Town Council is required **before** proceeding with these projects.



SEWER SYSTEM

Important Information

Please refrain from flushing rags, baby wipes, diapers, or any other items that are not biodegradable into the town sewer system.

Items such as these can plug the sewer pumps causing them to stop working which in turn, can result in sewer back up in homes.

Pet Owners:

Please clean up after your pets, especially when out walking them. All dogs and cats are to be kept from running at large in the Town and must be on a leash when not on your own property.



If using your sump pump please remember to direct the hose to the curb where the water will flow directly into the storm sewer system.

Trailer & RV Parking

A reminder to all that Recreational Vehicles are not to be parked on a residential street or public property continuously for any period exceeding 72 hours and that they must be parked on the driveway a minimum of 6.5 feet back from the

back of curb. Trailers must be attached to a vehicle when parked on public streets. For more information on the traffic bylaws please inquire at the Town Office.
