Building Permits

Who Needs a Building Permit?

All construction, renovations, demolitions, additions, or moving a building require a permit. Please make application at the Town Office in advance, as approval by Town Council is required **before** proceeding with these projects.



Landfill

Landfill users are reminded that the following items are not accepted at the landfill site: Animal carcasses of any kind, batteries, electronics, televisions, microwaves, stereos, DVD players, etc., tires, ashes, paint, or other items listed on the City of Yorkton's Bylaw #9/2013 schedule of prohibited wastes.

Minimum renovation/construction debris for small renovations is accepted into the construction waste bin. Fees subject to change. Contractors and/or property owners for larger construction projects are encouraged to make arrangements for their own containers for the removal of construction waste.

Clean Wood:

Trees and clean wood are accepted at the landfill to be placed in the burn pile.

Elm Tree

Elm tree trimming is **NOT** permitted from April 1st to August 31st.

Grass Clippings & Leaves

Important Information

The town will pick up bagged grass clippings and leaves in **clear plastic bags only** on Thursdays 8AM, weekly. Weight restriction is 30 pounds. Please do not place other items in these bags; doing so will result in the bag(s) not being collected. Please look for starting date in the Town Bulletin Board or on the website. Clear plastic bags may be picked up at the town office during regular working hours for free.

Composting

Important Information

You may take composting items to the landfill, free of charge, must be loose and not bagged and must not contain anything other than composting materials.

If using your sump pump please remember to direct the hose to the curb where the water will flow directly into the storm sewer system.

Sewer System

Important Information

Please refrain from flushing rags, baby wipes, diapers, or any other items that are not biodegradable into our sewer system. Items such as these can plug the sewer pumps causing them to stop working which in turn, can result in sewer back up in homes.
