Building Permits

Who Needs a Building Permit?

All construction, renovations, demolitions, additions, or moving a building require a permit. Please make application at the Town Office in advance, as approval by Town Council is required **before** proceeding with these projects.



Composting

Important Information

You may take composting items to the landfill, free of charge, must be loose and not bagged and must not contain anything other than composting materials.

Landfill

Landfill users are reminded that the following items are not accepted at the landfill site: Animal carcasses of any kind, batteries, electronics, televisions, microwaves, stereos, DVD players, etc., tires, ashes, paint, or other items listed on the City of Yorkton's Bylaw #9/2013 schedule of prohibited wastes.

Minimum renovation/construction debris for small renovations is accepted into the construction waste bin. Fees subject to change. Contractors and/or property owners for larger construction projects are encouraged to make arrangements for their own containers for the removal of construction waste.

REMINDERS:

Shingles:

As of June 1st, 2017 Shingles are now accepted at the Foam Lake Landfill. Tipping fees will apply.

Water Line Flushing:

Water Line Flushing will take place October 3rd to October 6th, 2017.

Clean Wood:

Trees and clean wood are accepted at the landfill to be placed in the burn pile.

Paying Bills Online

Those wishing to pay property taxes or water bills may do so online through the Credit Union or Royal Bank.

Elm Tree

Elm tree trimming is **NOT** permitted from April 1st to August 31st.

Grass Clippings & Leaves

Important Information

The town will pick up bagged grass clippings and leaves in **clear plastic bags only** on Mondays & Thursdays 8AM, weekly. Weight restriction is 30 pounds. Please do not place other items in these bags; doing so will result in the bag(s) not being collected. Clear plastic bags may be picked up at the town office during regular working hours for free.

Trailer & RV Parking

A reminder to all that Recreational Vehicles are not to be parked on a residential street or public property continuously for any period exceeding 72 hours and that they must be parked on the driveway a minimum of 6.5 feet back from the back of curb.

Trailers must be attached to a vehicle when parked on public streets. For more information on the traffic bylaws please inquire at the Town Office.

Sewer System Important Information

Please refrain from flushing rags, baby wipes, diapers, or any other items that are not biodegradable into our sewer system.

Items such as these can plug the sewer pumps causing them to stop working which in turn, can result in sewer back up in homes.

If using your sump pump please remember to direct the hose to the curb where the water will flow directly into the storm sewer system.

Keep Foam Lake Beautiful

Residents are encouraged to keep well-trimmed lawns and do their part to keep the dandelions to a minimum. Please remember that shooting grass out to streets and sidewalks will clog storm sewers.
