## Garbage Collection

As you are aware, the Town of Foam Lake has switched garbage collection to curbside pickup by Ottenbreit Sanitation Services. This new service commenced on September 12, 2017 and will continue bi-weekly on Tuesdays. We hope you have adjusted to this new service and are enjoying the convenience of curbside garbage collection. Please be reminded that all waste must be in appropriate trash bags, inside the bin so the lids will close. Oversized items should be taken to the Transfer Station; the hours of operation are Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Any questions or concerns can be directed to the Town Office, we will try to help you the best we can.



## Transfer Station

Transfer Station users are reminded that the following items are not accepted at the Transfer Station site: Animal carcasses of any kind, batteries, electronics, televisions, microwaves, stereos, DVD players, etc., tires, ashes, paint, or other items listed on the City of Yorkton's Bylaw #9/2013 schedule of prohibited wastes.

Minimum renovation/construction debris for small renovations is accepted into the construction waste bin. Fees subject to change. Contractors and/or property owners for larger construction projects are encouraged to make arrangements for their own containers for the removal of construction waste.

## REMINDERS:

### Water Line Flushing:

Water Line Flushing will take place October 3<sup>rd</sup> to October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017. The sediment in the lines is stirred up during this time and can create problems for laundry as water may be somewhat discolored. To reduce the sediment from entering your household lines, refrain or reduce water consumption during this time.

### Elm Tree

Elm Tree trimming is permitted from September 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup>.

### Paying Bills Online

Those wishing to pay property taxes or water bills may do so online through the Credit Union or Royal Bank.

## Sewer System Important Information

Please refrain from flushing rags, baby wipes, diapers, or any other items that are not biodegradable into our sewer system. Items such as these can plug the sewer pumps causing them to stop working which in turn, can result in sewer back up in homes.

## Building Permits

### Who Needs a Building Permit?

All construction, renovations, demolitions, additions, or moving a building require a permit. Please make application at the Town Office in advance, as approval by Town Council is required **before** proceeding with these projects.



## Snowmobiles in Our Town

### Be Aware That...

Snowmobile operators are requested to follow the snowmobile route as set out in Bylaw #17-95. Operation of a snowmobile is permitted from a **point of origin to the corporate boundaries of the town**, following the snowmobile route nearest entry or exit. All Highway Traffic and Snowmobile acts must be followed.

Have a safe snowmobile season.

## Composting Important Information

You may take composting items to the Transfer Station free of charge, must be loose and not bagged and must not contain anything other than composting materials.

### Trailer and RV Parking

As of October 1, all campers, trailers, or any type of recreation vehicle must be removed from the streets, frontage and front yards. Also please remember that any vehicle can remain on side of road for no longer than 72 hours.
