Did you know...

The following items are not accepted at the landfill:


Electronics - such as TVs, VCR's, Printers, Microwaves, Computers, Stereos, etc.

Florescent Light Bulbs, Batteries, Tires, Paint or Paint Cans, and Burning Barrels. Check with the landfill at 306-272-7901 if you have questions.

Recycling

Recycling for **residential** properties will continue every second Wednesday. Please have your carts out the day/night before. Collection trucks may begin as early as 5 AM and if the cart is not out; collection will not take place until the next pick up two weeks later. **Commercial** property collection is every second Thursday. Businesses must have tin, plastic, milk cartons, etc. bagged into a clear bag and placed into bin. Cardboard can be put in bin as normal. **NO GARBAGE IN CARTS OR BINS!**

Important Dates to Remember

Water Line Flushing:

Tuesday, October 6 through Friday, October 9, 2015. The sediment in the lines is stirred up during this time and can create problems for laundry as water may be somewhat discolored. To reduce the sediment from entering your household lines, refrain or reduce water consumption during this time.

Front Street Garbage Pick Up:

Pick Up on the Front Street will resume Tuesday, November 2, 2015.

Trailer & RV Parking:

As of October 1, all campers, trailers or any type of recreation vehicle must be removed from streets, frontage and front yards.

Snowmobiles in Our Town

Be Aware That...



Snowmobile operators are requested to follow the snowmobile route as set out in Bylaw #17-95. Operation of a snowmobile is permitted from a **point of origin** to the corporate **boundaries of the town**, following the snowmobile route nearest entry or exit All Highway Traffic and Snowmobile acts must be followed.

Have a safe snowmobile season.

Bylaw Enforcement and Pest Control

In Case You Want to Know...



The Town of Foam Lake works hard to keep the Town attractive to visitors, newcomers and residents through various means.

One of those means is Pest Control. Pest control refers to the regulation or management of a species defined as a pest, usually because it is perceived to be detrimental to a person's health, the ecology or the economy. Foam Lake has three designated Pest Control Officers appointed

by Council to make Foam Lake a pleasant place to live.

Bylaw Enforcement is another method used to keep Foam Lake neat, clean & safe. A bylaw enforcement officer is a law enforcement employee of a municipality charged with the enforcement of non-criminal bylaws, rules, laws, codes or regulations enacted by local governments. In Foam Lake Bylaw Enforcement is contracted

out, as per Council's decision. The majority of Bylaw Enforcement relates to the Nuisance Bylaw (Untidy & Unsightly Properties) and Animal Control Bylaws.

If you have any concerns regarding pests, nuisances or animals, please contact the Town Office so that the appropriate steps can be taken to resolve the issue.
