BYLAW NO. 1-2018

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPLICATION OF RATES FOR RECYCLING MANAGEMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR TRANSFERRING ANY UNPAID ACCOUNTS TO THE TAX ROLL.

The Council of the Town of Foam Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. All businesses, residences, institutions and community halls shall be subject to a Recycling Management fee as per Schedule "A".
- 2. Accounts for collection shall cover a period of three successive months as described:

December 13 to March 12 March 13 to June 12 June 13 to September 12 September 13 to December 12

- 3. Upon reasonable proof, any resident or business in the Town of Foam Lake that disposes of non-recyclable items in any curbside recycling cart or commercial recycling bin shall be subject to a surcharge as per Schedule "A".
- 4. Users that continue to disregard the correct recycling procedures, and have been subject to a surcharge on three (3) separate occasions will forfeit recycling privileges.
- 5. Pursuant to Section 369 of the Municipalities Act, any sum payable to the urban municipality for Recycling Management that remains unpaid on December 31 of the year in which the sum became payable is to be added to, and thereby form part of the taxes on the land and buildings in respect of which the collection, removal or disposal is done.
- 6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the 13th day of February, 2018.
- 7. Bylaw 5-2015 is hereby repealed

SCHEDULE 'A'

Bylaw No. 1-2018

Fees/Charges:

- 1. Recycling cart fee is \$5.00 per month per household, invoiced on the utility billing.
- 2. Those not wanting to recycle will still be charged the \$5.00 per month recycling fee.
- 3. If utilities are shut off and the dwelling is vacant there will not be a recycling fee, during this time.
- 4. If it is a seasonal shut off the \$5.00 per month fee will continue to apply.
- 5. A surcharge of \$150.00 will be charged to a user that has been proven to be in contravention of correct recycling procedures. Where a Commercial Recycling Bin is shared by two (2) or more users, each user will be equally responsible for the surcharge.
