

# Election 2016

## Who Can Run?

Persons eligible for nomination as a candidate in an urban municipality must:

- be at least 18 years old on Election Day;
- be a Canadian citizen;
- have resided in the municipality for at least 3 consecutive months immediately preceding the date nomination paper is submitted;
- and have resided in Saskatchewan for at least 6 consecutive months immediately preceding the date nomination paper is submitted.
- Nomination papers must be signed by at least 5 voters of the municipality or ward (if applicable), in urban municipalities with a population of less than 20,000.

## Who Can Vote or Nominate?

Eligible voters must be:

- at least 18 years old on Election Day;
- a Canadian citizen;
- a resident of Saskatchewan for at least 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day; and

either:

- a resident of the municipality for at least 3 consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election: or;
- an owner of assessable land for at least 3 consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election.

## Completing your Nomination Form:

- Nomination day is September 21, 2016; (nomination forms may be filed during regular business hours from the date of posting until September 20th and from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM on September 21st)
- Election day is October 26, 2016;
- Only complete the area for Mayor or Councillor as it pertains to you;
- Form must be witnessed by two people;
- Form must be accompanied by a Criminal Records check when submitted to the nominations officer or returning officer.
