## **Noise Bylaw 10-2003 Section 2.4:**

*"EVERY PERSON who owns or has the care of, control of, or keeps or harbours, any animal, which by reason of excessive barking or excessive howling disturbs other persons, is guilty of an offence under this bylaw."*

Please be responsible pet owners and monitor your dog's barking. Continuous barking is a disturbance for neighbours who are trying to enjoy a peaceful neighbourhood.
