CHASE THE ACE RULES

- 1. Tickets \$5 each
- 2. Winner gets 20% of the weeks' sales.
- 3. 30% gets added to the jackpot until the ACE of SPADES is drawn
- 4. 50% goes to the Foam Lake & District Health Foundation
- 5. Tickets may only be sold within Saskatchewan, to residents of Saskatchewan.
- 6. Tickets sales are restricted to those 19 years of age and older.
- 7. A maximum of 50,000 tickets may be sold, with a total prize value of \$125,000.
- 8. A standard deck of cards will be used.
- 9. Tickets will be sold at:
 - a. Foam Lake Pharmacy, 407 Main Street, Foam Lake
 - b. Foam Lake Credit Union, 402 Main Street, Foam Lake
 - c. Town of Foam Lake Office, 326 Main Street, Foam Lake
 - d. Willy's Tavern, 340 Main Street, Foam Lake
- 10. Weekly ticket draw takes place every Thursday from March 12th to December 31st 2020 at Willy's Tavern, 340 Main Street, Foam Lake at 7:00 pm
- 11. Tickets can be purchased up to 1 hour before the draw on Thursdays at Willy's Tavern, Foam Lake.
- 12. Holder of the weekly winning ticket must be present to claim prize, or have a Charity Appointed Proxy attend the draw. The weekly winning ticket number will be called up to five times in 15 minutes. If no one comes forward with the winning ticket after 15 minutes, that ticket is disqualified and another draw will be made.

- 13. If a ticket holder is unable to attend the draw; a Charity Appointed Proxy will be in attendance to act on behalf of the ticket purchaser. The designated Charity Appointed Proxies are: Brenda Kipling and Kent McMann.
- 14. Distribution of weekly ticket sales:
 - a. 20% will be awarded to the winning ticket holder.
 - b. 30% will be added to the growing Jackpot.
 - c. 50% will go to the Foam Lake & District Health Foundation Fundraising Account.
- 15. Weekly draw winner gets chance to win the jackpot by cutting the standard deck of cards. If the Ace of Spades is chosen from the deck of cards, the winner gets the jackpot, which includes the 30% of the ticket sales. If the Ace of Spades is not drawn, the selected card is removed from the deck and the 30% goes into the prize pot for the next week's draw.
- 16. At the end of each week's 'cut the deck' segment, the rest of the deck will be displayed, to show that the Ace of Spades is still in the deck.
- 17. The remaining cards from standard deck, shall be sealed in an envelope by Foam Lake & District Health Foundation Committee Members in charge of the draw.
- 18. Contest continues with the same standard deck of cards until the Ace of Spades is drawn.
- 19. Once the Ace is drawn, a new contest begins. The Jackpot resets to zero, and a new deck of cards will be used.
- 20. Only tickets sold during the current week are eligible for that week's draw. All previous tickets sold will be removed at the conclusion of each weekly draw.
- 21. No limit on the number of tickets that can be purchased for a draw.
- 22. No refunds will be allowed for any tickets purchased.
- 23. No receipts will be given for any tickets purchased.

- 24. If the winning ticket has more than one name on it, the prize will be awarded to the first person's name on the ticket. It is the responsibility of the Ticket Holder to distribute their winnings.
- 25. Foam Lake & District Health Foundation members, all volunteers and immediate family ARE allowed to purchase tickets BUT are not permitted to participate as the proxy in that week's draw. If one of that day's workers/volunteers has their ticket name drawn, that ticket will be discarded and a new ticket drawn.
- 26. Volunteers who are assisting with the draw that evening or sold tickets that week are not permitted to purchase tickets for the draw.
- 27. Beginning on Thursday, March 12, 2020, the raffle will continue for 10 months. The final draw will take place Thursday, December 31, 2020.
- 28. Total ticket sales for the duration of the lottery shall not exceed 50,000 in number. In the event that all 50,000 tickets are sold before the December 31, 2020 date, the draw will take place the Thursday that the final ticket is sold, with the Winning Ticket Holder receiving 20% of the weekly sales, and will be given a chance to cut the deck of cards for the Ace of Spades. IF the ticket holder does not cut the Ace of Spades, they will keep the 20% of the weekly ticket sales, with the remaining 30% to be added to the Jackpot, and another ticket will be drawn. Tickets will continue to be drawn, until a ticket holder cuts the Ace of Spades from the deck of cards, who will then receive the Jackpot total that has accumulated to that time, bringing this Chase the Ace event to it's conclusion.
