Water and Sewer Rates for 2023

The Water and Sewer Rates in Foam Lake will increase in 2023. These changes will be reflected in your March 2023 utility bill.

For the minimum Water and Sewer Rates, 5000 gallons or less, the new rates are as follows:

Water	\$80.83	\$84.24
Sewer	\$53.49	\$56.16
Infrastructure	\$48.63	\$51.06
Recycle	\$19.11	\$20.07
Total	\$201.46	\$211.53

Where Water and Sewer Rates over 5000 gallons, the new rates are as follows:

Water	\$10.02	\$10.50
Sewer	\$6.69	\$7.02
Total per 1000 gallons	\$16.71	\$17.52

2023 Dog Licenses and Business Licenses

Dog Licenses are required if you own a dog within the Town of Foam Lake. The cost of a dog license is \$15 for the calendar year.

Business Licenses are required if you plan to operate a business within the Town of Foam Lake. Business Licenses range from \$100 - \$250 and can be purchased at the Town of Foam Lake Office.

Renewal reminders will be sent out early in 2023. Watch for them in the mail!
