#### <u>Utility Bills and Property Tax Discount</u> Utility bills are due July 31, 2024.

Property taxes are due December 31, 2024.
A 3% discount on the Municipal portion of property taxes is available until July 31, 2024.

#### **Town of Foam Lake Payment Options**

- Online Banking through your Financial Institution
- E-transfer to reception@foamlake.com
- Cash/Cheque can be received through the mail, in person at the office or use our AFTER HOURS DROP-BOX beside the accessible entrance at the Town Office
- Debit payments can be made in person during regular office hours.

#### **Past Due Notices**

Past due notices are computer-generated reports that are mailed out once the due date for the bill has passed. These are not sorted through manually, so they may occasionally be mailed for small amounts or payments that are made after the report is generated.

#### E-Billing

The Town of Foam Lake now offers E-billing for property taxes and utility bills. Complete the form on our website or stop by the Town Office to sign up!

#### **Tree Trimming**

Residents are reminded to trim trees overhanging streets, sidewalks, and back alleys. Failure to do so will result in custom work charges. Branches can be taken to the Transfer Station free of charge Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays from 9am to 4:30pm. If this is not possible, please contact the Town Office to discuss alternate arrangements.

#### 2024 Dog Licenses and Business Licenses

Dog Licenses are required if you own a dog within the Town of Foam Lake. The cost of a dog license is \$15 for the calendar year. Restricted dogs are \$25.

Business Licenses are required if you plan to operate a business within the Town of Foam Lake.

Business Licenses range from \$100 - \$250 and can be purchased at the Town of Foam Lake Office.

#### Online Water Meter Reading Submissions

Ratepayers can now submit their water meter readings using the online form on our website: www.foamlake.com. Submissions MUST be sent using the online form during the designated times of the year.

#### **Water Line Flushing**

Water Line Flushing will take place during the first week in October. Lines are being stirred during this time which could cause sediment to enter lines. We ask that businesses and residents refrain from using water or reduce consumption during this time.

#### **FL Express Hours and Fees**

To book the FL Express, please contact 306-272-7122. The regular hours for the FL Express are Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 10:00am - 4:00pm. Round trip rate is \$5.00.

- After hour trips are \$20/Round Trip (Remember you need to book in advance).
- Out of town appointments are available at a rate of \$0.80/km. Must be booked a week in advance.
- Event bookings are \$80/event in town
